MONEY SAVINGS

CarShare Vermont members spend \$100 per month to share on average, compared to the \$500 or more to own a car.

CarShare Vermont members drive 35-50% less. This means less traffic, less pollution, and a healthier community for all.

When people drive less they become more connected to their community. They tend to shop locally and help contribute to a vibrant local economy.
